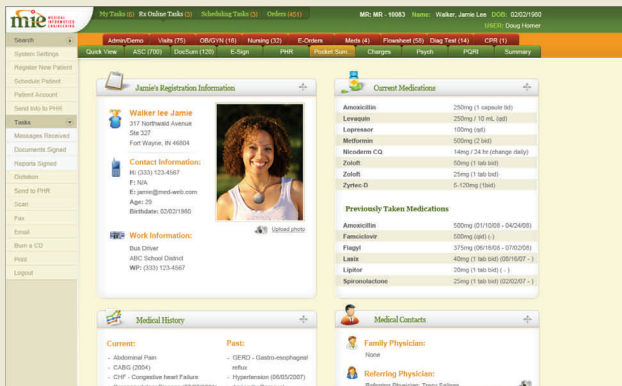

WebChart does not require client PC software, so access to WebChart is possible from any browser enabled device or PC—from home, the office or the hospital.

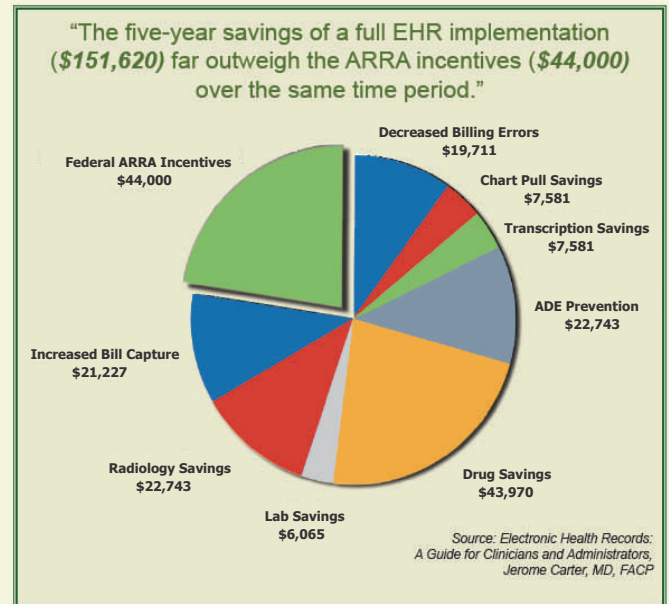

ARRA Incentives

The HITECH Act (Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Care Act), signed into law as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, created compelling financial incentives for physicians who adopt electronic health records (EHR) over the next five years.

Eligible physicians can realize \$44,000 in Medicare incentives or up to \$63,750 for Medicaid providers—paid out over a five year period. HITECH has published guidelines and qualifying physicians must implement and demonstrate meaningful use of a certified EHR beginning in 2011 for full reimbursement eligibility.

MIE guarantees that all WebChart products will fully meet or exceed final 2011 meaningful use standards as outlined by HITECH.
